The City of Greeley Natural Area and Trails Division is looking for Volunteer Trail Ambassadors to collaborate with the community by making a proactive effort to reduce social and environmental impacts on the heavily trafficked trails, natural areas and open spaces in Greeley and Weld County.



Job Summary - The Trail Ambassador will interact with visitors and recreators in an educational manner while encouraging proper trail use and behavior. You will walk, bike or skate the trails regularly to monitor for any issues with the trail, observing wildlife and trail user trends

Duties and Responsibilities -

- ❖ Become familiar with Greeley's trail system and trail regulations
- ❖ Educate Visitors about the park, trails, and surrounding areas
- ❖ Increase the safety of other trail users by reporting any dangerous conditions on the trail system
- ❖ Collect and report information about visitors and trail conditions
- ❖ Pick up trash or litter
- ❖ Answer questions relating to trail and park information – provide any directions or help if needed
- ❖ Commitment to outdoor stewardship and responsible recreation
- ❖ Completion of City of Greeley Natural Area and Trails training and orientation
