ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.08.600 OF THE GREELEY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE JUDICIAL REVIEW BOARD

WHEREAS, the Greeley Judicial Review Board was established in 2002 with a number of powers and duties; and,

WHEREAS, one such responsibility included at the Board's creation is that of reviewing citizen, staff, or attorney complaints; and,

WHEREAS, there are established 'complaint' procedures for citizens, staff and attorneys through District Court, the City's Human Relations processes, and the State of Colorado; and,

WHEREAS, it is unnecessary to create additional 'complaint' procedures through the Judicial Review Board and, accordingly, this provision of the Code should be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREELEY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Greeley Municipal Code Section 2.08.600, Formation of Judicial Review Board, is hereby amended as follows with deletions shown with strikethrough text, and additions shown in upper case text:

- (a) Board established. There is hereby established a Judicial Review Board, the purpose of which is to investigate, evaluate and make recommendations to City Council on the retention of the Municipal Court Judge. The Board shall be comprised of five (5) members. The Commission membership shall include at least one (1) licensed attorney, one (1) person with a criminal justice background, one (1) representative from the from the general public.
- (b) Powers and duties. The Board shall have the powers and duties to:
 - (1) Develop and recommend an evaluation system for the Municipal Court Judge which shall be transmitted to City Council for approval, modification or rejection;
 - (2) Develop and recommend a survey of judicial performance to be disseminated to the public;
 - (3) ~~Review citizen, staff, or attorney complaints; and~~
 - (4) (3) Perform other such duties as may be prescribed by City Council or as defined further in Board rules of procedure.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its final publication as provided by the Greeley City Charter.
