



FAST FACTS: EMERGENCY SERVICES

Emergency services in the North Greeley Study Area are provided by multiple agencies. Fire protection is supplied Union Colony Fire Rescue Authority. Emergency medical services are provided by Weld County Paramedic Services. In the incorporated areas the City of Greeley Police Department has jurisdiction, while the unincorporated county is policed by the Weld County Sheriff's Department. Both the City and the County have emergency management offices that operate in the event of a disaster.

The Union Colony Fire Rescue Authority provides fire and rescue services in the City of Greeley, including all of the annexed areas north of the Poudre River. In the unincorporated portions of the study area, the Windsor-Severance Fire Protection District provides fire services generally west of 71st Avenue and the Eaton Fire Protection District to the east of 71st Avenue.

Weld County Paramedic Services provides paramedic services for all of Weld County. The Paramedic Services strive to provide swift response to calls, the goal being to respond to over 90% of call within 9 minutes in the City, and to greater than 95% of the calls within 15 minutes in the rural areas of Weld County.

The City of Greeley Police Department operates in the incorporated areas of the North Greeley Study Area, while in unincorporated Weld County the Weld County Sherriff's Department provides service. The City of Greeley Police Department actively enrolls neighborhoods in the Neighborhood Watch program, and they enlist local businesses to partner with police in the "Operation Safe Stay" program. The Greeley Police Department is also part of the "Neighborhood Building Blocks" program, which, along with 14 other City agencies, collectively addresses neighborhood issues. In addition to regular police functions, the Weld County Sheriff's Department manages the Weld County Jail, located within the Study Area.

These multiple agencies together provide emergency services and promote public safety in the North Greeley Study Area. There is a high level of cooperation between the various agencies, an example of which are the mutual aid and response agreements to provide high quality emergency services throughout the study area
