Geographic Area Descriptions

Northeast Greeley Neighborhood: Generally the area which lies north of 8th Street, south of the Cache la Poudre River, west of 1st Avenue, and east of 23rd Avenue. (Includes the two areas formerly known as the 5th Street Neighborhood and the North Greeley Neighborhood.)

Sunrise Park Community: Generally the area which lies north of 15th Street, south of 9th Street, west of 2nd Avenue, and east of 5th Avenue. (Expansion pending Council's approval of the neighborhood study. Expanded boundaries – the area which lies north of 16th Street, south of 5th Street, west of Highway 85 Bypass, and east of 8th Avenue.)

14th Avenue Neighborhood: Generally the area which lies north of 16th Street, south of 13th Street, west of 11th Avenue, and east of 16th Avenue Court.

West 10th Street Corridor: Generally the area between 11th Avenue and 23rd Avenue which lies north of 10th Street and south of 8th Street and the area between 23rd Avenue and 35th Avenue which lies north of 16th Street and south of 4th Street. (This area includes a Tax Increment District along 10th Street.)

UNC / Hillside Area: Generally the area between 10th Street and US 34 Bypass which lies west of the Union Pacific Railroad and east of 11th Avenue and the area between 11th Avenue and 17th Avenue which lies north of US 34 Bypass and south of the University of Northern Colorado's West Campus. (Excludes University of Northern Colorado owned properties.)

Downtown: A 15 block area in downtown Greeley which generally lies north of 11th Street, south of 5th Street, west of the Union Pacific Railroad, and east of 11th Avenue. (This area is a Tax Increment Financing district.)

John Evans Neighborhood: Generally the area between Highway 34 Bypass on the north, 32nd Street on the south, 23rd Avenue on the west, and 11th Avenue on the east. (Only the areas inside the Greeley City limits are included.)

At Large: City-wide.
