Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Application for Rebate for a Commercial Energy Audit

The City of Greeley offers financial assistance for energy audits (EA) for commercial buildings located in the Redevelopment District (see map) through the gREeNEWAL™ Program. These funds are provided to business/building owners with qualifying structures. An energy audit will provide information to determine appropriate energy efficiency and conservation (EEC) measures that will reduce the use of energy in the facility. These measures can lower expenses related to energy use and to reduce the environmental impacts associated with the use of fossil fuels. A maximum of \$300 is available to offset the costs of a qualified EA.

How to get an Energy Audit of your business:

1. Contact your Xcel Energy account manager or call the Business Solutions Center at 1-800-481-4700 to discuss options and register for an audit. The audits are performed by an independent engineer. The cost for an audit for facilities less than 25,000 square feet is \$200 or for facilities larger than 25,000 square feet the cost is \$300. It generally takes 2 weeks for the audit to be performed after it has been scheduled and another 2 to 3 weeks to get the report. Or,
2. Contract independently with a company trained in performing energy audits. Costs will vary but generally will be in the range of \$1000 to \$2000. (Note: The maximum rebate through the City of Greeley is \$300.)

How to apply for the rebate:

1. Verify your business is located in the Redevelopment District.
2. Have a qualifying energy audit completed and pay the invoice.
3. The audit must have been done after January 1 2010.
4. Complete the application for a rebate.
5. Provide a copy of the audit report and proof of payment.
6. Complete the Affidavit of Lawful Presence.

The rebate program is subject to available funds. A separate application to request low-interest loan funds to implement identified EEC measures is available on the web page.
