Rocky Mountain Senior Games is an athletic event for seniors age 50 and over. Any senior, male or female, is eligible to participate in the games. Registration deadline is May 21, 2012. This years events include archery, badminton, bowling, cycling, field events, golf, power walking, Pickleball, racquetball, road race, rowing, shuffleboard, swimming, table tennis, Race Walking, tennis, track, trap and skeet shoot, 8 ball and 9 ball. New for the 2012 games is the pole vault.

The National Senior Games will be held in Cleveland, Ohio in July 2013. Competition on the state level is the only way to qualify for nationals. However, you have to qualify for the National games in 2012. Greeley is the only Colorado city for qualification for the national games.
