## **STORMWATER BOARD MINUTES August 3, 2011**

**ATTENDANCE:** Board Members attending were Don Beierbach, Jim Belleau, Dale Cook, Jon Osterlund and Julie Them. Jim Lord was excused. Dave Nalley was introduced as the new Board Member, replacing Jay Freese. Staff Members attending were Ron Hoagland and Ellen Hine.

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** The Minutes were approved as written by a Motion made by Julie Them and seconded by Dale Cook.

### **AGENDA TOPICS:**

#### **Flood Issues & Solutions:**

We met with Pastor Mike at The Vineyard Church to look at the flood proofing that was done to help alleviate flooding problems.

The Board would like Terri Kohls to educate the public about flood proofing their property. The Board would also like the Stormwater Division to give limited monetary assistance to residents who are having flooding issues to help them flood proof their properties. Dale Cook made a Motion, seconded by Julie Them, to set up a training class with residents who are having flooding problems.

Dale Cook made a Motion, seconded by Julie Them, to have Ron Hoagland check with the Greeley Chamber of Commerce to see how we could go about training the public.

#### **Project Update:**

**35<sup>th</sup> Avenue & 22<sup>nd</sup> Street:** Aslan Construction was awarded the contract and they should start in approximately one week. This project will be very disruptive to traffic and should last approximately three months. The city put in a new access road for Greeley West High School to help move traffic in and out of the north parking lot during construction. There is a 27" water line that was installed in 1930 and we are concerned about getting underneath that line and not disrupt water supply in the city.

**35<sup>th</sup> Avenue Regional Detention Pond:** This project has started with the contractor burying concrete rubble. Phase II will be a storm drain collection system. Phase I should be completed by March, 2012.

**Jackson Spillway:** The spill gate is not working properly; it moves too slow. A new gate will be installed which will open more quickly and be more efficient. The cost is \$60,000. #3 Irrigation Ditch has committed to giving \$15,000 towards the cost; nonpotable water has committed to giving \$7,000. The Street Department will help with the installation.

**Belair:** We hope to start this project early next year. There is not enough time to get the construction done and sod put in before the residents will have to be turning off their sprinkler systems this year.

**OPEN - OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Old Business:** Ron will schedule a tour of current projects with the Board within the next couple of months.

**ADJOURNED:** The meeting was adjourned at 5:40 p.m. by a Motion made by Julie Them and seconded by Dave Nalley.
