

2010 Sculpture on Loan Program

Sponsored by the City of Greeley &
The Greeley Art Commission

In 1995, the Commission initiated the Sculpture on Loan Program with the placement of three pieces of art in the Downtown area. Each year, the Commission solicits art to be on display for one year in public areas and community parks. The Greeley area consists of a viewing population of nearly 100,000. We currently have twelve spaces to display outdoor sculpture and hope to expand with six more near the downtown Greeley businesses. It is Greeley's honor to exhibit these sculptures so that the public may enjoy the artists' talents and purchase accordingly. Each year, with citizen input the City purchases one or more sculptures to be added to the permanent art collection.

- Artists lend their work to the City for one year for a \$500 honorarium
- Artists will deliver work to the city during March & April, 2010
- The artist agrees to leave the work on display until Feb. 2011
- The City agrees to publicize and provide insurance for the work
- The City Parks department will assist the artist with installation
- If artwork is sold, the City of Greeley will retain a 30% commission

Each sculptor may enter up to three pieces of outdoor sculpture. Suggested height is 3' or more. Fragile, dangerous or inappropriate work will not be considered. Selected artists will be provided with further details.
