TYPE OF PERMIT		FEE
<b>CANDLES AND OPEN FLAMES IN ASSEMBLY AREAS</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to use open flame or candles in connection with assembly areas, dining areas of restaurants or drinking establishments.	\$28.00 per use (\$100.00) annual permit for fixed use
<b>EXPLOSIVES OR BLASTING AGENTS</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to manufacture, store, handle, sell or use any quantity of explosive, explosive materials at a fixed facility. For fireworks sales, fireworks displays and pyrotechnical events see the specific section.	\$140.00
<b>FIREWORKS, DISPLAY, OUTDOORS</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to conduct an outdoors fireworks display.	\$275.00
<b>FIREWORKS, SALES, INSIDE AN ESTABLISHED PERMANENT STRUCTURE</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to store, handle or sell fireworks within a permanent structure.	\$1500.00
<b>FIREWORKS, SALES, INSIDE A TEMPORARY STRUCTURE</b>		\$1500.00
<b>FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to use flammable or combustible liquids at a temporary construction site or special event.	\$70.00
<b>LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to store, use, handle or dispense LP-gas.	\$70.00 per tank or cage
<b>LIQUID OR GAS-FUELED VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT IN AN ASSEMBLY BUILDING</b>		\$70.00
<b>MALL, COVERED</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to use a covered mall in the following manner: Placing or constructing temporary kiosks, display booths, concession equipment or the like in the mall; To use a mall as a place of assembly; To use open-flame or flame-producing devices; To display any liquid or gas-fueled powered equipment.	\$70.00

<b>OPEN BURNING</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit for the kindling or maintaining of an open fire or a fire on any public street, alley, road or other public or private ground as a use of any non- agricultural based use.	No fee
<b>PYROTECHNICAL SPECIAL EFFECTS MATERIAL</b>	For permits for pyrotechnical special effects material before a proximate audience	\$275.00
<b>TEMPORARY MEMBRANE STRUCTURES</b>	This fee is required to obtain an operations permit to operate an air-supported temporary membrane, tent or canopy regulated by the adopted fire code.	\$30.00 per temporary structure
<b>ALTERNATIVE COMPLIANCE/RADIO AMPLIFICATION</b>	This fee is required to obtain a permit to install performance based alternatives.	\$275.00
<b>ALTERNATIVE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEMS</b>	This fee is required to obtain a permit to install alternative extinguishing systems.	\$140.00
<b>AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEM, MODIFICATION ALL</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to extend, modify or alter an existing automatic sprinkler system (minimum of 4 heads to be added or relocated before a fee is required).	\$130.00 +\$1.00 per device
<b>AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER, 13 AND 13R</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install a new automatic sprinkler systems in multifamily residential, hotel, business or commercial facilities	\$250.00 +\$1.00 per device
<b>AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER 13D</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install new automatic sprinkler systems in single family detached housing.	\$110.00 +\$1.00 per device
<b>FIRE ALARM SYSTEM, NEW</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install a new fire alarm system or to replace a fire alarm system.	\$350.00 +\$1.00 per device

<b>FIRE ALARM SYSTEM, MODIFICATION</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit for extensions, modifications or alterations of fire alarm system (minimum of 4 devices to be added or relocated before a fee is required)	\$ 140.00 + \$ 1.00 per device (initiating or notification device)
<b>FIRE PUMP</b>		\$275.00 + system fee
<b>FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUID TANKS INSTALLATION OR REMOVAL</b>	This fee is required to obtain a permit to install or remove flammable or combustible liquid tanks	\$225.00 +\$75.00 per additional tank
<b>FUEL DISPENSERS</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install or modify fuel dispensers	30.00 per dispenser
<b>HOOD AND DUCT PROTECTION SYSTEM</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install hood and duct protection systems.	\$200.00 +\$1.00 per device
<b>LP-GAS INSTALLATION PERMANENT</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install LP-gas systems.	\$90.00 per tank
<b>LP-GAS INSTALLATION -TEMPORARY</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install LP-gas systems or containers for a period less than six months.	\$90.00 per tank
<b>OIL WELL</b>	This fee is required to obtain a review and inspection of oil well equipment and facilities	\$165.00
<b>SPRAY BOOTHS OR ROOMS</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install booths or equipment or construct rooms used for the spraying, dipping or drying of flammable or combustible liquids.	\$165.00
<b>STANDPIPE</b>	This fee is required to obtain a construction permit to install standpipe system	\$75.00 per floor

TYPE OF PERMIT		FEE
<b>ADDITIONAL PLANS REVIEW</b>	This fee shall be paid for the review of plans when changes are made to the plans that have been previously approved	\$70 per hour (\$30.00 paid at submittal)
<b>AFTER HOURS INSPECTION</b>	This fee shall be assessed whenever, at the request of a contractor or building owner, the Fire Department conducts an inspections after or before the normal business hours of 08:00 and 17:00 Monday through Friday or any time on weekends.	\$ 125.00 for each inspector, for the first two hours. \$ 60.00 per hour per inspector for each additional hour.
<b>COPIES – INCIDENT REPORT</b>	This fee is required to obtain copies of inspection or incident reports.	\$5.00
<b>FIRE HYDRANTS AND FLOW TESTING</b>	This fee is required to obtain flow data information intended for fire-suppression or engineering purposes.	\$70.00 per location
<b>REMOVAL OF STOP WORK ORDER</b>	This fee shall be paid in order to remove a “Stop Work Order” issued by the Fire Department. In addition to this fee, a re-inspection fee shall be paid and if after normal working hours the cost of the after-hours inspection will be assessed and shall be paid prior to the lifting of the “Stop Work Order”.	\$140.00 for first offense, double the previous fee for every stop work order issued thereafter.
<b>REINSPECTION FEE</b>	This fee shall be assessed for each re-inspection when: an inspection is called and is not complete when the inspector arrives; when corrections called out on a previous inspection are not made; or when a contractor does not have the permit card or the plans are not available to the inspector.	\$60.00 per hour
<b>RESEARCH AND RETRIEVAL</b>	This fee is required to obtain research and retrieval of records for specific locations or information.	\$35.00 per hour (min one hour charge)
