

## ABOUT TOINTON GALLERY

The Tointon Gallery, 651 10th Avenue, presents twelve changing art exhibits each year to the community. Artwork is displayed with a wide variety of media, artist styles and skill levels to provide enjoyment, education and to encourage dialogue about art. The gallery can be accessed through the first floor lobby of the Greeley Recreation Center and is open Monday through Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is free.

### AWARDS

All prizes and ribbons will be provided by the City of Greeley and will be presented at 5:30 p.m. during the opening art reception.

The City of Greeley will judge artwork in the exhibit and award the following:

**City Purchase Awards-** Artwork may be purchased for display in city-owned buildings and may become a part of the Greeley Public Art Program's permanent collection.

#### Student Division

1st Place Winner in each category:

Grades K-2

Grades 3-5

Grades 6-8

Grades 9-12

Students who wish to be eligible for a City Purchase Award must enter the Adult Division and will not be considered for awards in the Student Division.

## Arts Picnic Fine Art Exhibit

The City of Greeley is proud of the magnitude of talented artists residing in Weld County. As a sponsor of our community art exhibit, The Arts Picnic strives to promote and encourage the arts while improving the quality of life in Greeley.*



## ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists residing in Weld County. Artwork must have been produced in the last two years and not previously shown in the Tointon Gallery.

## EXHIBIT

In order to allow ample space for each work of art entered, we will accept ONLY the first 100 applications in the Adult division. To maintain variety in the overall exhibit we may limit applications for any one media to 25% of the total number of pieces in the show. The number of student applications accepted will not be limited.

- All forms of fine art are eligible for display.
- Limit one piece per artist.
- The gallery will not collect a commission.
- There is no entry fee.
- All artwork must be delivered on time.
- Work must stay on display until show closes.
- All art will be displayed at the discretion of the Tointon Gallery Visual Arts Committee.

**Adult 2-D work** must be properly framed and ready to hang by a wire. Maximum size for 2-D work is 150 inches. To determine total inches, measure all four sides of the frame and add the numbers together.

**Student 2-D work** may be matted, mounted, and/or framed and must be ready to hang.

**All 3-D work** must be ready for display.

## LIABILITY

Works will only be insured while they are on the premises and only from July 23, 2018 - August 27, 2018. Artwork is not required to be for sale, but the insurance value is required. Claim reimbursement is subject to verifiable value.

## ARTIST RECEPTION

The Arts Picnic Fine Art Exhibit Reception will be held on Friday, July 27 from 5-7 p.m. in the Tointon Gallery.

## ARTS PICNIC KICK-OFF CONCERT

The Arts Picnic Kick-Off Concert will follow the reception beginning at 7 p.m. on the 9th Street Plaza. The concert is presented by The City of Greeley and co-sponsored by the Downtown Development Authority and Sears Real Estate.
