Item 2:	Q: Can the City share its budget for this project? A: There has been no identified budget at this point.

Is this to be a Time and Materials not to exceed?</li><li>A: The contract may change dependent on the number of appeals and/or conceptual designs recommended. However, the contract shall meet time and materials per task as identified in the Scope of Services.</li></ul>		
Item 4:	<ul> <li>Q: Which City personnel will be involved in Progress Meetings?</li> <li>A: The City PM will be present at all Progress Meetings. The Stormwater Manager and Public Works Director may be present dependent on the agenda for the meeting. Additional City personnel may be present dependent on the meeting and impact to City project and maintenance areas.</li> </ul>		
Item 5:	<ul><li>Q: Will there be additional meetings expected with other City shareholders?</li><li>A: At this time it is expected that such meetings could be folded into contracted and scheduled progress meetings.</li></ul>		
Item 6:	<ul><li>Q: Does the City expect the consultant to hunt for and identify new topographical information?</li><li>A: The consultant may identify and propose additional topographical information if they have any to offer. The consultant is not expected to produce new Lidar or research and identify City CIP projects or recent developments. The City will provide this information to the best of its ability.</li></ul>		
Item 7:	<ul><li>Q: Can consultants utilize the City's surveyor for additional information?</li><li>A: The City's surveyor does not have the capacity to assist on this project.</li></ul>		
Item 8'	<ul> <li>Q: Has the City consulted with other municipalities or Weld County regarding any questions on hydrology.</li> <li>A: The City has had conversations with Ft. Collins, Windsor and Weld County. None of expressed specific concern with hydrology.</li> </ul>		
Item 9:	Q: Regarding Section J, what is the process involved in terms of confidential and proprietary information? A: Any confidential and/or proprietary information must be designated in the consultant's response/proposal. The RFP outlines information that cannot be deemed proprietary and/or confidential.
