Question #1	Will the city be purchasing the concrete, or will that be up to the concrete contractor?	
Answer	The City is not supplying concrete.	
Question #2	Is there a site to dispose of Rip rap, muck, concrete and asphalt?	
Answer	The City is not providing a site for waste materials.	
Question #3	On the muck excavation line, is the 57 rock used to replace the muck part of that line or is it a separate line item?	
Answer	Aggregates for muck replacement have separate pay items.	
Question #4	There is graffiti on the existing abutment is that to be removed? If so is that an addendum?	
Answer	Graffiti removal is not included in the Work.	
Question #5	On page 5 of the plans it shows the existing sidewalk is staying, but on page 7 it says to remove the side walk. what is getting removed and what is getting left?	
Answer	Sidewalk removal under the bridge is in the bid schedule quantities and is noted on Sheet 7 as it may have to be removed. This will be determined by the Engineer after it has been exposed. If it is not removed, the estimated quantity will be deleted from the Contract by Change Order.	
Question #6	On page 7 of the plans it calls to remove some storm pipe, what size is it?	
Answer	The existing storm pipe is 24" CMP.	
Question #7	Are there any flow rates on the water?	
Answer	Sheepdraw base flows have not been measured. The flow rates vary seasonally and may be impacted by agricultural irrigation. Sheepdraw floodplain hydrology is available and is presently being restudied. The bridge design flow was 4090 CFS (100-YR). The 2-YR was 335 CFS.
