Considerations on Models/Presentations

Key Questions to Answer

- What is the problem that needs to be addressed? Questions include:
 - Citizen access to broadband?
 - Business access to broadband?
 - Lack of broadband adoption?
 - Better competition with existing providers?
 - Need to compete with neighboring jurisdictions?
- Why is the City of Greeley exploring solutions?

Network Models Under Consideration

- Establish a City-run broadband network
- Enter into a Public Private Partnership (PPP) with a new provider
- Collaborate better with existing providers (including marketing services)

Things to Keep in Mind

- City of Greeley does not have a municipal electric system
- There is not an example of another City the size of Greeley without a municipal electric system that has developed and deployed a municipal network
