Greeley Art Commission July 21, 2020; 6.c Deaccessions:

De-Accession 'Peakview Panels' - the 2002 project is currently located in Peakview Park and is continually defaced with scratches on the directional photographic panels beyond reasonable repair. The artwork was originally intended to be a set of four photographic plaques of the western horizon set on sandstone plinths with wording pointing out landmarks that can be seen from the highest point in the park and one round plinth displaying a map of Greeley. After many years of needing maintenance including a replacement of all five plaques in 2017, it has been determined that to replace the panels again with new plaques would not be a good use of taxpayer dollars. City staff recommends the deaccession of this project for the following reasons: The artwork causes excessive or unreasonable maintenance and the artwork is damaged irreparably, or to an extent where repair is unreasonable or impractical.

Deaccessioning is the process used to remove, permanently, an object from the collection through sale, trade or other means. Deaccessioning requires the approval of the majority of the members of the Greeley Art Commission for two consecutive votes, with a public announcement of the proposed action to permit public input. The donor and/or artist will be notified of the Greeley Art Commission's intent when possible. Deaccessioning shall be a seldom employed action that operates with a strong presumption against removing artworks from the collection.

It was moved and approved by the Art Commission to move forward with the process to deaccession the Peakview Panels currently located in Peakview Park, W 13th St & 58th Ave, Greeley, CO 80634. The motion passed unanimously.

The next Greeley Art Commission meeting and the final vote to deaccession the sculptural set of artwork will be held on September 15, 2020 at 4pm. The meeting is open to the public remotely via ZOOM.
