BEER & WINE TASTING PERMIT APPLICATION

The following fee must accompany this Beer & Wine Tasting Permit Application:

- \$100 for Initial Application Fee; OR
 - \$25 for Annual Renewal Fee
 - Written Control Plan describing how the Beer & Wine Tasting Event will be controlled and conducted in accordance with State statutes and the Greeley Liquor Code (for example identification verification, monitoring unconsumed samples by patrons, how unconsumed beer & wine will be destroyed after event, etc.)
 - Certification or documentation for employees completing required Responsible Vendor Training

- ✓ Beer and wine tasting events shall not exceed a total of five (5) hours in duration per day, which need not be consecutive;
- ✓ beer and wine tasting events shall be conducted only during the operating hours in which the licensee on whose premises the alcohol beverage tasting events occur is permitted to sell alcohol beverages, and in no case earlier than 11:00 a.m. or later than 7:00 p.m.;
- ✓ beer and wine tasting events may occur on no more than four (4) of the six (6) days from a Monday to the following Saturday, not to exceed one hundred four (104) days per year
- ✓ the size of an individual beer or wine sample shall not exceed one (1) ounce for both

Beer and Wine Tasting events will be conducted on the following days and hours:

Any deviation from this schedule shall be reported to the City Clerk’s Office and the Greeley Police Department in writing at least 48 hours prior to Beer and Wine Tasting Event.
