Greeley and Recreational Marijuana



What you need to know



What is Amendment 64?

In 2012 Colorado voters approved the recreational use of marijuana under Amendment 64 and on December 10, 2012 the new law became effective. Under this law, cities have the ability to regulate certain aspects related to the use and sale of recreational marijuana. Greeley, like other cities, has taken that opportunity to pass additional restrictions for the safety of the community.

There are four areas where you'll need more information on how the new laws work in Greeley.

- Personal use of recreational marijuana
- Personal growing of marijuana
- Possession and sale of accessories for marijuana consumption
- Manufacture and sale of recreational marijuana



Personal Use

Amendment 64 and Greeley laws authorize the personal use of marijuana by individuals over the age of 21. Personal use includes the following:

- Possessing, using, displaying, purchasing or transporting up to 1 ounce of marijuana;
- Possession of all the marijuana produced by your plants on the premises where the plants were grown;
- Transfer of up to 1 ounce of marijuana to another adult age 21 or over without remuneration (payment);
- Consumption of marijuana provided that consumption is not conducted openly and publicly or in a manner that endangers others;
- Assisting any other adult age 21 or greater to do all of the above activities.

Marijuana Growing

Amendment 64 and Greeley laws allow:

- Possessing, growing, processing, or transporting of no more than 6 marijuana plants, with 3 or fewer being mature, flowering plants;
- Marijuana growing in an enclosed, locked space and when it is not conducted openly and publicly and is not available for sale;
- Non-commercial personal and/or medical marijuana to be grown only in single-family detached homes in an area no bigger than 32 square feet.
- No marijuana may be grown at or on multi-family residential commercial or industrial properties.

Marijuana Accessories

Amendment 64 and Greeley laws remove “marijuana accessories” from the definition of drug paraphernalia if the marijuana accessories are used or possessed by a person age 21 or over.

Marijuana Accessories means any equipment, product, or materials of any kind which are used, intended for use, or designed for use in planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, composting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packaging, repackaging, storing, vaporizing, or containing marijuana, or for ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing marijuana into the human body.

Commercial/Retail Marijuana

Amendment 64 authorizes commercial marijuana establishments which include the following:

- Marijuana cultivation facilities
- Marijuana testing facilities
- Marijuana product manufacturing facilities
- Retail marijuana stores

However, the City of Greeley has banned all commercial/retail marijuana establishments within the city limits. The operation of marijuana clubs where individuals would gather for the sole purpose of using marijuana have also been banned, as well as testing and product manufacturing facilities.
