Becky Safarik, Assistant City Manager, invited the Commissioners to attend a thank-you dinner to celebrate the successful season of the Cold Weather Shelter hosted by the United Way on April 17, 2017.

Ms. Safarik distributed copies of the new home rehab brochure for GURA that was designed by the City's Community Engagement & Marketing Department.

Ms. Safarik reported that the G-HOPE program is growing in success with 28 loans to date. The G-HOPE program was developed to increase the stability, appeal and investment in the established residential areas surrounding the University, Downtown and Central Greeley by encouraging home ownership for the employees associated with the major employers in this district. Eligible applicants are regular, full-time employees of the City of Greeley, University of Northern Colorado, Weld School District 6, or Banner Health/NCMC at the time of home purchase. It is hoped to expand the group of employers that are eligible to participate in the program in the next year.
