What are the benefits of the program?

- People get help on projects they cannot complete themselves.
- People get an opportunity to help those who really need it.
- More households will comply with city ordinances.
- Neighbor relationships are strengthened.
- City's beautification efforts get a boost.

What is Neighbor Labor?

Often people need help with neighborhood or home-maintenance projects, but they just can't seem to get it, so the projects never get done.

To address these needs the City has created the Neighbor Labor Program to get people the help they need for projects. The help comes from a network of volunteers willing to assist the elderly or people with a disability with home-maintenance tasks.

There are also opportunities for group projects including general neighborhood cleanup or tree-planting.

Bottom Line: Neighbors are helping each other.



Neighbor Labor:
Building strong neighborhoods by matching those who want to help with those who really need it.

How does the process work?

Call the City's Neighborhood Resource Office for an application.

Complete the application and send it back to NRO who will screen for eligibility. Criteria: age, disability status, income. If eligible, the City will send your request to United Way of Weld County (UW).

UW will match a volunteer from their pool to the job.. UW will coordinate the work schedule.

What kinds of jobs are eligible for neighbor labor?

Property maintenance the owner can't do themselves

- Weed abatement
- Yard maintenance
- Snow removal on sidewalks

Neighborhood clean up projects

- Clean-ups
- Tree planting

What kinds of jobs are NOT eligible for neighbor labor?

Property maintenance owner CAN do themselves

Commercial (for profit) activities
