CPRD COVID-19 Adjusted Operations - January 7, 2021

Beginning today, the City of Greeley Culture, Parks and Recreation Department will operate with **Level Orange** capacity limits and all other CDPHE Level Orange guidelines. Greeley Recreation will continue to follow all guidelines outlined by [CDPHE](#), as well as requiring masks in all facilities. Visitors will be required to register for an activity in advance.

Facility restrictions due to the new health order include:

- **[Greeley Recreation Center](#)**: Room capacities operate at 25% capacity; other areas are increased as follows:
 - Weight Room – 15 people total
 - Fitness Room – 10 total
 - Auxiliary Gym – 12 total
 - Main Gym – 24 total
 - Lap Swim/Water Walking – 3 people per lane – 24 total
 - District 6/Swim Club – 32 max in water at a time (no more than 50 in pool area including spectators)
 - Racquetball Courts – 2 per court
 - Climbing Wall and Archery Range remain closed
- **[Family FunPlex](#)**: Room capacities operate at 25% capacity; other areas are increased as follows:
 - Weight Room – 25 people per session (includes cardio/weights – social distancing equipment)
 - Cycling Studio – 10 total (social distancing bikes)
 - Fitness Studio – 12 total
 - Walking Track – 15 total
 - Fieldhouse/Gym – 12 per court, 36 total
 - Lap Swim/Water Walking – 15 people
 - Swim Lessons – 25 participants per session
 - Open Swim and Child Care not available at this time
 - Lockers/showers remain closed
- **[Organized Sports](#)** – groups of up to 10 players (excluding coaches, referees/umpires) per court/field, maintaining social distancing 6 feet between non-household contacts. Only outdoor recreational sports permitted.
- **[Greeley Ice Haus](#)**: Room capacities operate at 25% capacity; other areas are increased as follows:
 - Open Skate Sessions – 50 people total
 - Learn to Skate programs, Drop-In Hockey, Stick & Puck, Freestyle – 25 total
 - Off-Ice Training Center – 10 total
 - Adult Hockey – will follow organized sports criteria – 10 players (excluding coaches and officials)
 - Greeley Youth Hockey Association & Colorado Eagles – are working towards a variance from the State of Colorado. The variance would approve Colorado Amateur Hockey Association (CAHA) events to include skills and drills, full team practices and contests (games or scrimmages) effective immediately for all properly registered USA Hockey and CAHA members. No spectators in the stands will be allowed.
- **[Greeley Active Adult Center](#)** will remain closed; no determination when this facility will re-open at this time.
- **[Union Colony Civic Center](#)** will allow rental groups only at this time – 50 people per floor (first & second floors only) with social distancing reserved seating. Pre-purchased tickets with contact tracing information required.
- **[Greeley History Museum](#)** – Original target opening date of January 2021 has been postponed until further notice.
- **[Island Grove Regional Park](#)**: Room capacities operate at 25% capacity or 50 total per room.
- **[Greeley Golf](#)**: Highland Hills and Boomerang Links restaurants will have continued limited capacity.
