 - a. Plumb Farm Tree Carving (slide # 1) – Staff and the RAMP committee recommends deaccessioning the tree carving of the pioneer couple done by artist Berndt Savig that is located at the Plumb Farm, 955 39th Avenue . The carved sculptured was previously owned by the City Museums and was accepted into to Public Art Inventory in 2000 with the intention to restoring and maintaining the carving to prolong its useful life. Approximately \$10,000 was invested to have a metal frame inserted in the core of the tree, reinforced with wood glue and to have it installed on a concrete pad near the original tree. It was noted at that time that the tree was deteriorating from the inside. Although the tree carving has been regularly patched and sealed with wood sealer, it has continued to deteriorate through the outside surface. Staff recently inspected the piece and believes the artwork to be in such a deteriorated state that restoration would prove either unfeasible or misleading.
