Per addendum 2, for SUE it is assumed that the Consultant needs to plan for 15 testholes (potholes) for Phase 1. How many SUE testholes (potholes) should the Consultant plan for during Phase 2? **10**
2. Due to the Coronavirus does the City prefer to have the proposal emailed instead of hard copies? **Yes**
3. Do the resumes count towards the 15-page limit? **This was clarified in the mandatory pre-proposal meeting – No**
4. Is there access to a copy of the roadway/survey work from Greeley Public Works for the portion of the project from 4th Street to "F" Street? **Yes**
5. Are the accuracy and datums used in the survey work from 4th to F Street by others for the 35th Avenue roadway project to be used for that portion of this project? **Yes**
6. Is the successful consultant responsible for survey work from F Street north to "O" street? **Yes**

8. Will the east limit of survey be the open channel on the east side of 35th Ave. between C Street and the Poudre River? **The survey needs to be sufficient for the design for the sanitary sewer line east of the open channel**

9. What level of detailed survey work needs to be done near and inside the pump station for non-potable water/30" waterline? **Enough to design the piping layout to the existing system.**
10. What survey datums are to be tied into the new survey work for horizontal and vertical work and do these include section corners, 1/4 corners, etc. and are they the same ones used for the current 35th Avenue street design/survey project between 4th and F Streets that David Well is working on in Public Works. **Yes**
