Agriculture & Food

- 66% of businesses experienced revenue growth in 2020
- 60% expanded their workforce
- 53% developed new products
- 27% struggled to meet increased market demands
- 67% plan to expand their workforce in 2021
- 27% are limited to their current footprint due to a shortage of industrial space in Greeley



Construction Products & Services

- 33% higher industry concentration than the national average
- 77% have established strong local business partnerships
- 62% experienced supply chain disruptions in 2020
- 62% suffered revenue and workforce loss
- 46% hope to expand their workforce in 2021
- 38% are considering expanding their current location





Energy & Power

- 10X higher oil & gas concentration than the national average
- 86% have established strong local business partnerships
- 50% invested in R&D to offer new products or services in 2020
- 82% experienced revenue and workforce loss
- 38% plan to invest more on R&D in 2021
- 38% are limited to their current footprint due to a shortage of industrial space in Greeley





Education

- 72% innovated new ways to maintain service levels in 2020
- 61% have established strong local business partnerships
- 61% experience challenges attracting and retaining qualified talent
- 50% regularly lose talent to other regions & school districts
- 33% aiming to increase enrollment in 2021
- 44% plan to invest in developing their existing workforce







Health Services

- 91% have established strong local business partnerships
- 39% regularly recruit talent from Aims and UNC
- 78% face challenges attracting and retaining qualified talent
- 70% suffered revenue and workforce loss during 2020
- 65% experienced supply chain disruptions due to Covid-19
- 48% see the opportunity to expand their workforce
- Projected to be Greeley's fastest growing industry over the next five years



Professional Services

- 82% of businesses experienced revenue growth in 2020
- 53% expanded their workforce
- 24% struggled to meet increasing market demands
- 53% have difficulties attracting qualified talent
- 65% plan to expand their workforce in 2021
- 47% would like to expand their current facility
- Projected to be Greeley's second fastest growing industry over the next five years
