In an attempt to help our employees and their families achieve this goal, the City of Greeley Employee Benefit Plan Trust, under the direction of the Health Board, contracted CareHere to provide a wellness center for employees, spouses, and dependents enrolled in the health plan.

CONFIDENTIAL

The City of Greeley Employee Wellness Center (EWC) is operated by CareHere. CareHere operates the EWC with a Medical Doctor, Nurse Practitioner, and Registered Nurse. All providers are employed by CareHere and all patient personal health information (PHI) is kept completely CONFIDENTIAL. CareHere is subject to strict HIPAA privacy rules and regulations.

No or Very Little Cost to You

The EWC is at no cost to City of Greeley employees, spouses and dependents enrolled in the Choice (PPO) Health Insurance plans; however, those that have elected the High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) there is a \$20 copay for non-preventative services.

This option does not affect your current medical coverage in any way. You still have full coverage as normal under your insurance plan. This is an additional benefit available to you that is convenient and affordable.

How do I register?

Each eligible participant must be registered separately. There are two ways a patient can complete registration with CareHere. Patients can call 877.423.1330 or follow the steps below at www.CareHere.com to register.

- 1. Click Member Login
- 2. Click I need to register for the first time with my Access Code
- 3. Enter your Access Code: CGRCP2 (Cigna PPO) **CGHSA4** (CIGNA HDHP)
- 4. Click Go
- 5. Provide responses to the ALL questions on the next 4 web pages of the health questionnaire, including Contact Data and Health and Behavioral Data.

How do I schedule an appointment?

Once registered, you can schedule an appointment by calling 877.423.1330 or by following steps below at www.CareHere.com with your computer, smartphone, or tablet.

May I have a copy of my electronic medical record faxed to another doctor?

Yes. We will be more than happy to fax your electronic medical record to another doctor on your behalf. To process your request, we will need the following information:

- · Your name, date of birth, and the last four digits of your SSN.
- The name and fax number of the doctor or practice to which you would like your electronic medical record to be sent.
