Greeley Police Department Ride Along Application Instructions

- A) The Ride Along Application must be completed and submitted to the Greeley Police Department at 2875 10th Street, Greeley, Colorado or faxed to 970-351-5433.
- B) You must sign the waiver in the presence of a police department representative. If you submit your application by mail, you can sign your waiver at the time of your ride along in the presence of the officer with whom you will be riding.
- C) Individuals less than 18 years of age on the scheduled ride-along day must be signed by a parent or legal guardian meeting the guidelines indicated above. The minimum age for ride alongs is 16 years of age. Waiver of this rule shall be approved by the chief of police or captain.
- D) Please allow 3-5 days to process your ride along application and to schedule your ride along.
- E) The Police Department will make every effort to accommodate your request for a ride along, however not all requests can be accommodated. Please allow for some flexibility in scheduling.
