

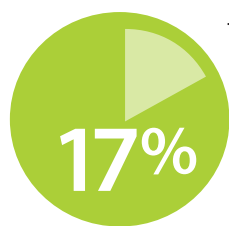
There Are Lots of Reasons to Support Aven's Village

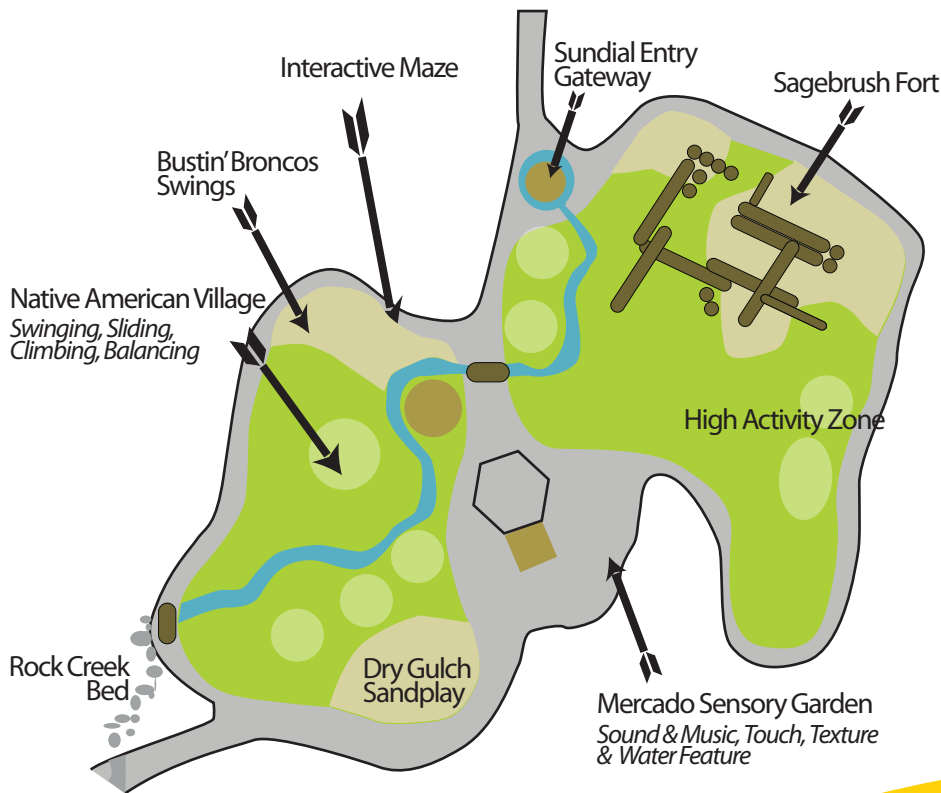
