ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists residing in Weld County. Artwork must have been produced in the last two years and not previously shown in the Tointon Gallery.

EXHIBIT

In order to allow ample space for each piece of art entered, we will accept ONLY the first 100 applications in the Adult division. The number of student entries is not limited.

- All forms of fine art are eligible for display.
- · Limit one piece per artist.
- The gallery will not collect a commission.
- There is no entry fee.
- All artwork must be delivered.
- · Work must stay on display until show closes.
- All art will be displayed at the discretion of the Tointon Gallery Visual Arts Committee.

Adult 2-D work must be properly framed and ready to hang by a wire. Maximum size for 2-D work is 150 inches. To determine total inches, measure all four sides of the frame and add the numbers together.

Student 2-D work may be matted, mounted, and/or framed and must be ready to hang.

All 3-D work must be ready for display.

LIABILITY

Works will only be insured while they are on the premises and only from July 25, 2016 - August 29, 2016. Artwork is not required to be for sale, but the insurance value is required. Claim reimbursement is subject to verifiable value.

ARTIST RECEPTION

The Arts Picnic Fine Art Exhibit Reception will be held on Friday, July 29 from 5-7pm in the Tointon Gallery.

ARTS PICNIC KICK-OFF CONCERT

The Arts Picnic Kick-Off Concert will follow the reception beginning at 7pm on the 9th Street Plaza and will feature Funkiphino. The concert is presented by The City of Greeley and co-sponsored by the Downtown Development Authority and Sears Real Estate.
