

EVENT PERMIT APPLICATION PACKET INSTRUCTIONS

Included in this packet are:

1. Event Permit Application

- If you intend to **block a street or a portion of a street**, you must include a map. This map should show a) the location of the event, b) the places where you will be blocking the street, and c) what you will be using to block the street.
- If you are planning an event that involves **crossing streets** (parade, march, race, etc.), you must include a map. This map should show a) the start/end point(s), b) the route of the event, and c) the locations of people monitoring the intersections.
- If you are planning an event that will take place **in a park**, you may need to reserve the park through the Greeley Recreation department.

2. Sound Amplifying Permit Application

- If you intend to use **amplified sound** (speakers, PA system, megaphone, etc.), you must complete the Sound Amplifying permit application
- Please note that this permit does not negate Municipal codes about extreme noise levels and/or late night events. No sound amplification equipment shall be used prior to 7:00AM or after 10:00PM.

3. Neighbor Notification Form

- If you intent to **block a street or portion of a street**, you must complete the Neighbor Notification Form.

You will receive a call when your permit has been approved. Your approved permit will include any additional specifications regarding your specific event.

PERMIT APPLICATION

SOUND AMPLIFYING EQUIPMENT

Chapter 9.32 Greeley Municipal Code

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 9.32, GREELEY MUNICIPAL CODE, A PERMIT TO UTILIZE SOUND AMPLIFYING EQUIPMENT AS BELOW IS GRANTED WITH THE FOLLOWING SPECIFICATIONS:

1) NO SOUND AMPLIFYING EQUIPMENT SHALL BE USED PRIOR TO 7:00 A.M. AND AFTER 10:00 P.M. OUT-OF-DOORS, OR INDOORS WITH SOUND PROJECTION OUT-OF-DOORS; 2) NO SOUND AMPLIFYING EQUIPMENT SHALL BE USED WITHIN 500 FEET OF A SESSION OF CITY COUNCIL OR A LEGALLY CONSTITUTED COURT; 3) NO SOUND AMPLIFYING EQUIPMENT SHALL BE USED AT A SOUND LEVEL WHICH CAUSES SUFFICIENT DISTURBANCE TO RESIDENTS OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD THAT THEY REQUEST POLICE ASSISTANCE IN STOPPING THE SOUND AMPLIFICATION IN PROGRESS. UPON NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANT OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE BY A POLICE OFFICER, THE SOUND LEVEL MUST BE APPRECIABLY REDUCED TO TERMINATE RECEIPT OF RESIDENT COMPLAINTS. REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH SUCH A REQUEST WILL IMMEDIATELY VOID THIS PERMIT.

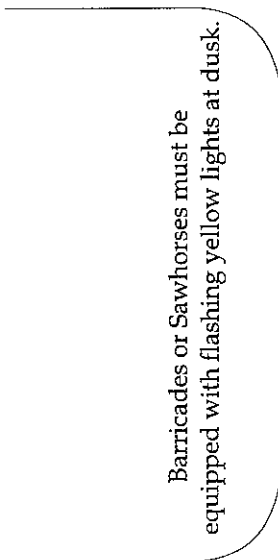

For locations that involve more than one block, a site-specific traffic control plan will be required.

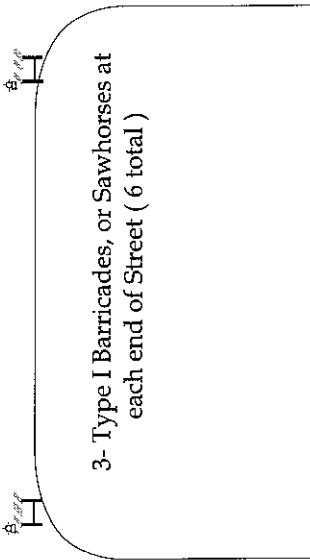
Traffic Control Devices needed to close one typical residential block.

IF YOUR STREET DOES NOT MEET THIS CONFIGURATION, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A SITE SPECIFIC TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN WITH YOUR APPLICATION.
