Addendum Questions	
Question #1	Is it intended that we need to tie-in new bored conduit to existing signal pole caissons? Do we need to use the existing conduit stubs out of the caissons, or can this be done external to the caisson?
Answer	The tie-ins will be at the existing conduits out of the caisson.
Question #2	If we believe some of the quantities to be off (potholing, uniformed traffic control), should we assume the quantity we believe is needed, since the project bid items are all lump sum?
Answer	Assume that the project plans include approximate quantities. The contractor is responsible for quoting actual quantities that they believe are needed for the project.
Question #3	If concrete items overrun, will they be paid for, or because the bid is lump sum, should it all be included?
